How to use your general waste bin

Advice on when to start using your bin will be provided when your bin is delivered.

Your collection will continue on a **weekly basis**.

Your bin should be placed on to the curtilage (or as instructed by the council) by 7.00am on collection day. Bins should be placed with handles facing the road. Once the bin has been emptied, you should return it to your property as soon as is practicable.

Bins should not be permanently stored on the pavement.

The lid must be closed.

Only the contents of the bin will be collected.

Excess waste should be kept until the following week **not placed by the side of the wheeled bin.**

Your bin is meant for household rubbish. If there is enough space, you can put in light garden rubbish such as grass cuttings.

Please do NOT put the following in the bin:

- **Hot ashes**
- **Builders' rubble**
- **Garden soil and stones**
- **Large metal objects**
- **Corrosive materials and liquids**
- **Tree branches**

The wheeled bin remains the property of East Riding of Yorkshire Council and should not be taken with you if you move.
