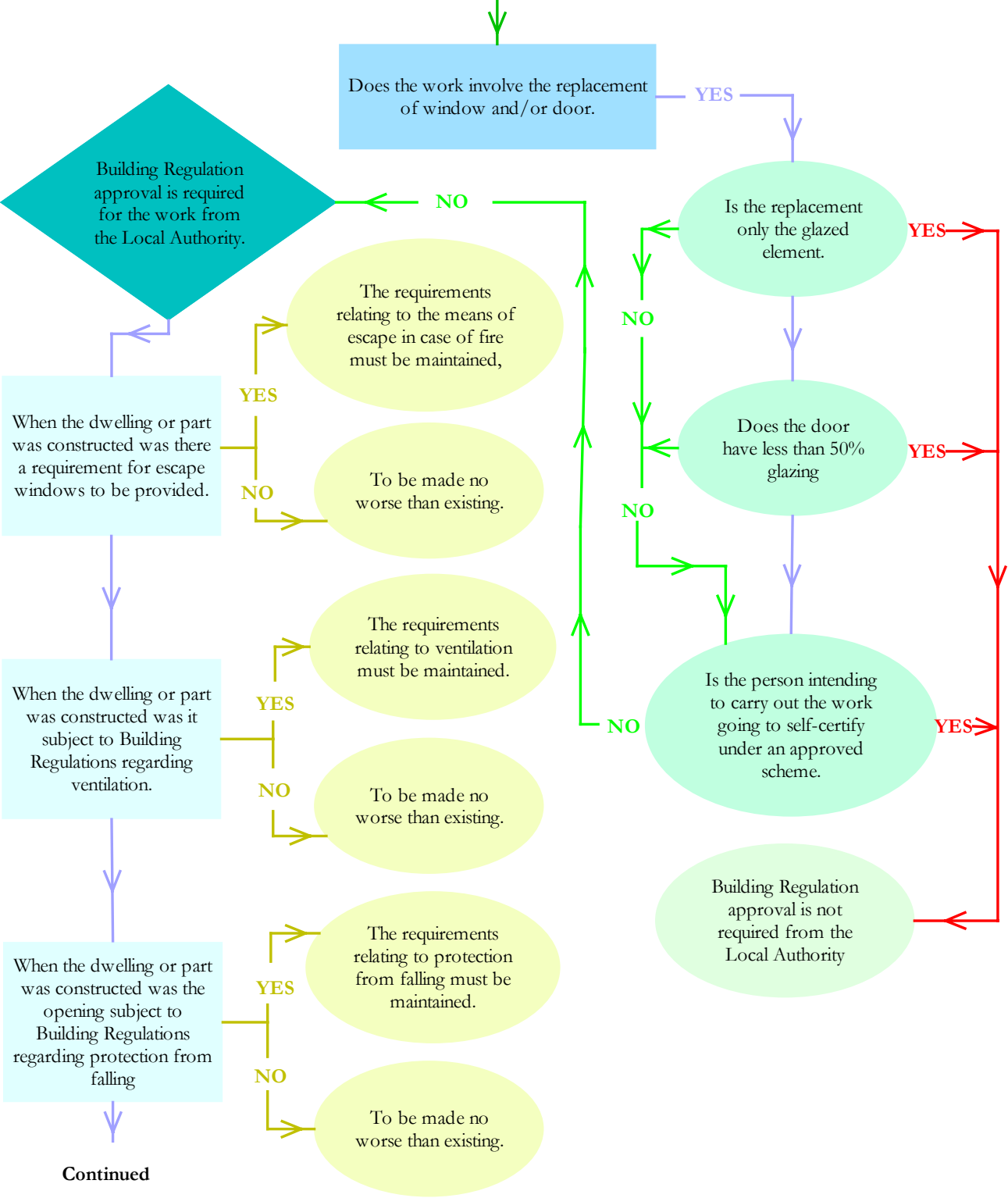
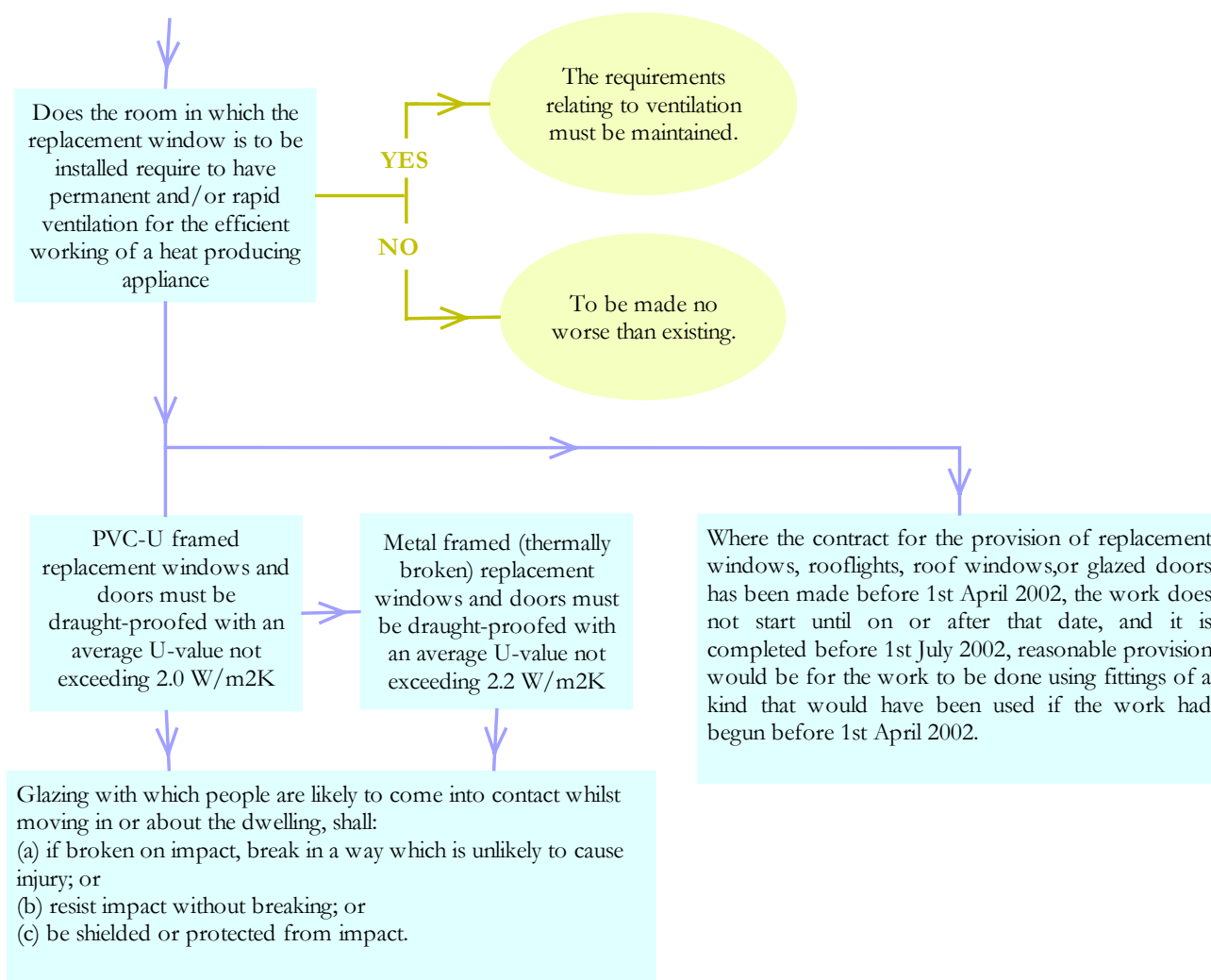


REPLACEMENT WINDOWS AND DOORS

From the 1st April 2002 the meaning of "building work" is to be amended to include the provision of a replacement window, rooflight, roof window, door (being a door which together with its frame has more than 50 per cent of its internal face area glazed)
It does not include the replacement of individual panes of glass where the frame is to remain.
