NOTICE is hereby given that from 31 July 2009 to 27 August 2009 (inclusive) between the hours of 9.30 am and 4.30 pm Monday to Friday at County Hall, Beverley, any person interested in the above bodies may inspect and make copies of the accounts for the year ended 31 March 2009 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto.

NOTICE is also given that on 28 August 2009 between the hours of 9.30 am and 4.30 pm the auditors appointed to audit the above accounts will, at the request of any local government elector within the area covered by the relevant body, give to that elector or his representative an opportunity to question them about the accounts and that any such elector or his representative may attend before the auditors and make objections as to any matter in respect of which the auditors could take any action under Sections 17 or 18 of the Audit Commission Act 1998 (namely, an unlawful item of account, failure to bring a sum into account or a loss or deficiency caused by wilful misconduct), or could make a report in the public interest under Section 8 of the Act.

Questions may be received at County Hall, Beverley by arrangement with the Auditor, Mr M Kirkham, District Auditor of Room 205, Crosskill House, Mill Lane, Beverley, East Riding of Yorkshire, HU17 9JB to whom requests for this purpose should be addressed.

No objections may be made to the accounts unless the auditors have previously received written notice of the proposed objection and the grounds on which it is to be made. A copy of this notice of objection must also be sent to the East Riding of Yorkshire Council's Head of Finance.
