### Why visit?

After taking a stroll through the lovely gardens and trails around Sewerby Park it is an ideal place to rest your legs and have a warm drink and a bite to eat, without busting the wallet.

This lovely converted courtyard stable block dates back from the 1820s and is certainly one of the most historical food establishments in the area.

### What's on the menu?

There is quite a varied selection of mainly snacks and light bites, but bigger meals are also sometimes served from the specials board.

Jacket potato with salad and various fillings start from £4.05. The popular filled paninis offer six different fillings, such as steak and onion or tuna melt and are priced between £4.25 and £4.55. Healthier options include salads with various fillings, priced from £3.75.

Also a good variety of sandwiches and baguettes add to the food on offer and prices start at a reasonable £1.75 for sandwiches and £2.25 for

the baguette. Crumpets (£1.05), scone with jam and cream (£1.65) and homemade cakes at £2.50 are among the other choices.

On the drinks front there is a large selection of hot and cold drinks. Tea is £1.55, with latte, cappuccino or hot chocolate at £1.95.

The kids menu at £3.30 includes a

sandwich, fruit, drink and crisps.

### Ambience

On a snowy winter's morning we arrived as the first customers, but by the time we left, the place was filling up and the atmosphere was warm and welcoming.

### Customer service

Very good. Our hot drinks were produced immediately and the toasted teacakes were ready within a couple of minutes. Our server was friendly and chatty.

### The punters

Mostly locals at this time of year, though we could hear a few west Yorkshire accents around from those who had come for the day.

### Worth going back

Certainly. The tea rooms are now a regular "pit stop" on our walks around Sewerby. We usually take friends who are visiting and they certainly like the lovely views over the floral clock and the lovely peaceful setting.
