ENTRY NUMBER (internal use only):

- All entries should be taken to the estate office or sent in the post if appropriate.
- The competitions are open to residents in the UK (including residents of the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man).
- Photography competition categories are split into juniors (15 years old and under) and seniors (16 years and over). There will be one winner in each category selected from a short-list of ten finalists.
- The winner of each competition will receive the prize as indicated in the event details. No cash alternative is available and the prize cannot be transferred or sold.
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Employees of East Riding of Yorkshire Council and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- Entrants under the age of 15 years need to have parent or guardian consent to enter.
- Any pictures submitted by post will not be returned. The organisers accept no responsibility for entries lost, damaged or delayed in the post.
- Each entrant can submit up to two photographs up to A4 in size in either colour or black and white. Photographic entries may need to be supplied electronically for publicity purposes.
- Images may be digitally enhanced to remove spots or scratches but not manipulated. East Riding of Yorkshire Council and the judges reserve the right to exclude any image they believe has been excessively altered so as to alter its authenticity.
- Each picture should be accompanied by a completed entry form. The reverse of the picture must also state the name of the photographer, address, contact number, competition name and the location of where it was shot.
- Copyright remains with the photographer but by entering the competition he/she gives permission for East Riding of Yorkshire Council to use the image on its website and in any publicity.
- If successful, the entrant agrees to provide East Riding of Yorkshire Council with the original file for the image and agrees that it can be printed and used in a public exhibition of winning entries. Winning entrants must agree to take in post-competition publicity. While we make every effort to credit photographers, we cannot guarantee that every use of the photograph will include their name.
- All the entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. If you take pictures of children (under the age of 16) you must have written permission from their parents. This written permission must then be sent in with the photographs. Entrants must not have breached any laws while taking their photographs.
- We may use a selection of the best pictures to appear in our online galleries. East Riding of Yorkshire Council reserves the right not to publish any photographs.
- By entering the competition, the entrant verifies that he/she has read these Rules of Entry and agrees to abide by them. East Riding of Yorkshire Council reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competitions at any time at its discretion if it is believed the entrant has breached any of the rules.
- If the winner fails to come forward after reasonable attempts have been made to contact them, East Riding of Yorkshire Council reserves the right to either offer the prize to a runner-up.
- These rules are governed by the Laws of England and Wales. This competition is administered by East Riding of Yorkshire Council.
- Pumpkins will not be returned to the entrants. Bug Hotels and autumn / winter artwork must be left in place until after the event.
