PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020**

On 28 October 2021 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the full length and width of a footpath some 52 metres in length commencing at Grid Reference TA 1825 6679 (Point A on the Map) and leading east-south-easterly to Grid Reference TA 1828 6676 (Point B on the Map) as shown on the Order map.

The Order comes into force as from 4 November 2021, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 28 October 2021 make an application to the High Court.
