PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020**


The above Order made on 15 July 2020 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish the full length and width of a footpath some 52 metres in length commencing at Grid Reference TA 1825 6679 (Point A on the Map) and leading east-south-easterly to Grid Reference TA 1828 6676 (Point B on the Map).

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment any representations or objections which have been duly made and not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
