

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981
THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**

**THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL
(HOLLYM BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NOS 7, 8 AND 9)
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2021**

The above Order made on the 12 February 2021 if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding:

- a) A length of Byway Open to All Traffic in the parish of Hollym some 1330 metres in length commencing on Hollym Road at Grid Reference TA 3420 2464 (Point A on the Map) and leading east-south-easterly for some 200 metres then south-south-westerly for some 1130 metres to join Welwick Bridleway No. 2 at Grid Reference TA 3387 2351 (Point B on the Map). Known as Myers Lane. The Byway Open to All Traffic will have a width of 12.2 metres.
- b) A length of Byway Open to All Traffic in the parish of Hollym some 182 metres in length commencing at Grid Reference TA 3506 2479 (Point C on the Map) and leading south-easterly to join Hollym Footpath No. 5 at Grid Reference TA 3518 2466 (Point D on the Map). Known as South Leys Road. The Byway Open to All Traffic will have a width of 12.2 metres.
- c) A length of Byway Open to All Traffic in the parish of Hollym some 947 metres in length commencing at Grid Reference TA 3419 2519 (Point E on the Map) and leading south-westerly to join Hollym Bridleway No. 3 at Grid Reference TA 3342 2504 (Point F on the Map). Known as South Carr Dales Road. The Byway Open to All Traffic will have a width of 12.2 metres.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order or if any so made are withdrawn, The East Riding of Yorkshire Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment any representations or objections which have been duly made and not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
