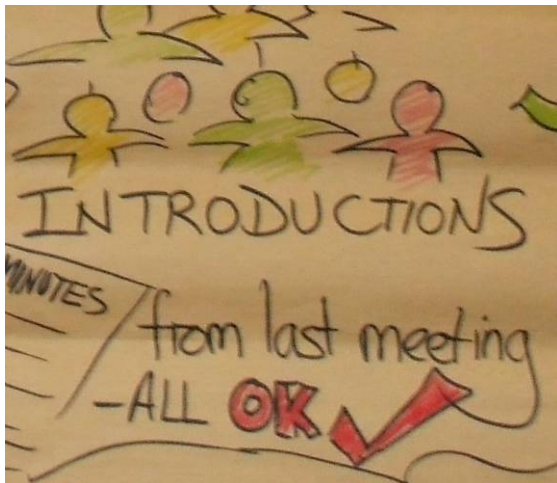


# EAST RIDING LEARNING DISABILITY PARTNERSHIP BOARD

Hello & Welcome from Rosy and Alison

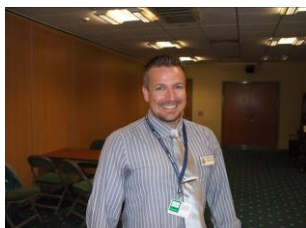
Introductions were made and apologies given



The minutes of the previous meeting were agreed as an accurate record.

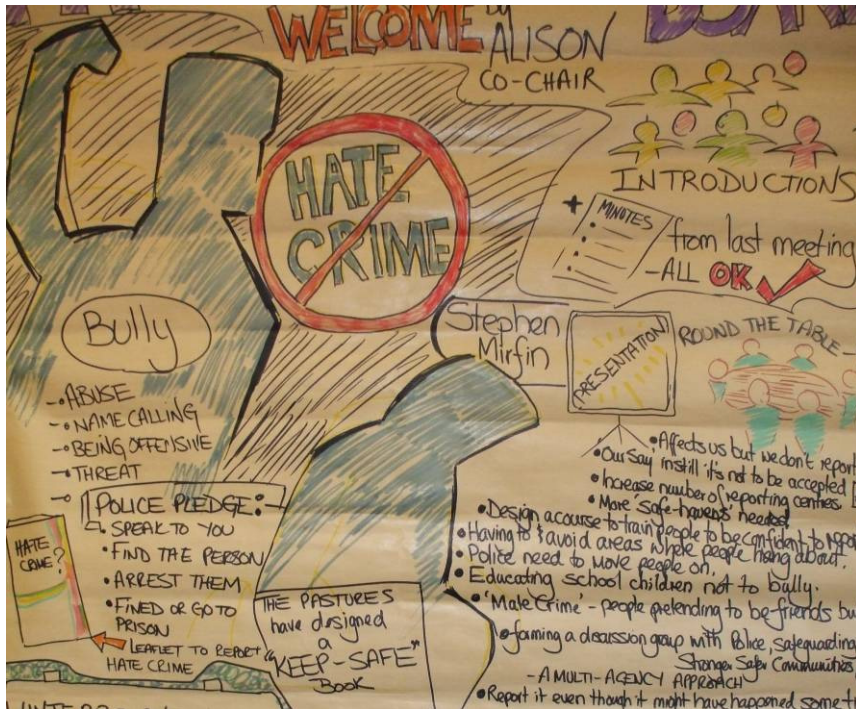


Presentation by Stephen Mirfin, Hate Crime & Divers Community Officer – Humberside Police

3. What would you like the Partnership Board and Stephen and his team to concentrate on?



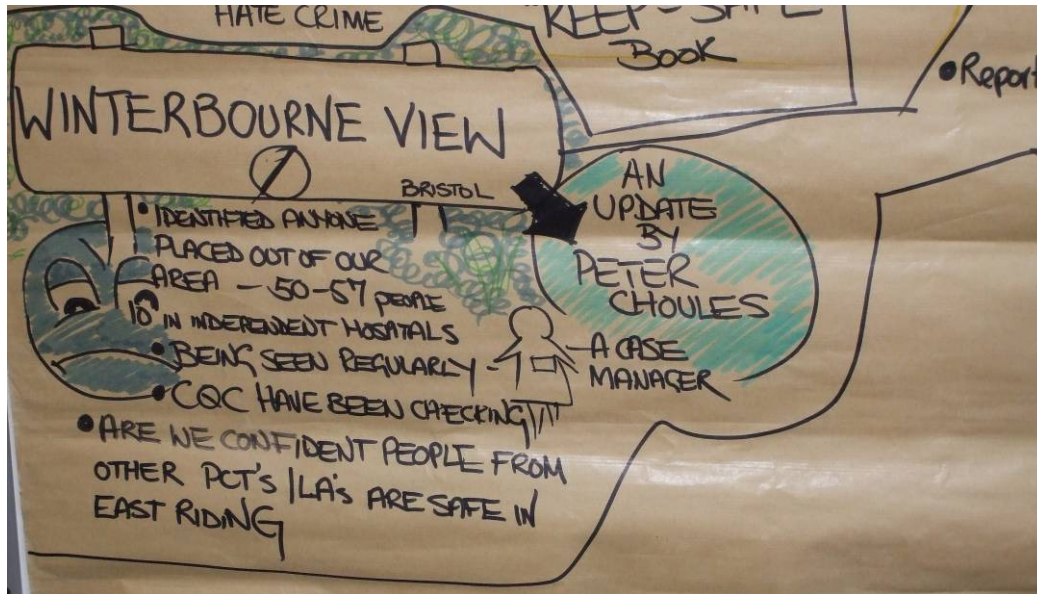
## FEEDBACK FROM ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION
