- Stephen Murfin asked that it be clarified to everybody that, although it was mentioned during his presentation on Hate Crime, the 'safe place' scheme with Tesco and Sainsbury's has only been discussed and nothing definite has been set up as yet.
- Liane mentioned that she attended a Hate Crime meeting recently and said that the East Riding Council are taking this issue very seriously and are 'getting better' re. Hate Crime reporting. There will be a discussion with partners about this.



5. Workshops

Julie Arnold introduced today's workshops. Julie said there would be 25 minute sessions at each table for discussion. Sub-Group chairpeople will move around each table, and have their input too. The sub-group chairs went around the tables and explained their work plans. Everybody had an opportunity to ask questions about the work plans, and give their input also.




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We carried on with rest of the workshops during the second half of the meeting.

Rosy said there is a Carers Review going on at the moment, Key people from the Carers Advisory Group (CAG) are looking at this as well with regards to the money available, and is it being spent appropriately on existing services etc. It will go out to consultation eventually.

Yvonne Rhodes said a big piece of work is ongoing at the moment regarding respite as a whole, not just learning disability, and will start to look at what is available at the moment, again not just learning disability. Yvonne said she is to look at this in the coming financial year and this will feed into the Learning Disability Partnership Board and the Older Peoples Mental Health Partnership Board plans.
