I, Nigel Pearson, as the Police Area Returning Officer appointed at the Election for the Police and Crime Commissioner for the Humberside Police Area on 15 November 2012, hereby certify that:

The total number of valid first preference votes cast for each of the candidates is as follows:

The total number of ballot papers verified is 136,071.

The turnout in this police area at this election is 19.48%

The total number of rejected ballot papers is 2,303.
