**Notes**

- Note 1 This figure is not included within the **total PCNs** as they are not recognised as such
- Note 2 This figure includes PCNs that are within the appeals procedures and are still awaiting an outcome from that process
- Note 3 As of the 31st March 2012 the council had no cases that had reached this stage of the CPE process
- Note 4 A PCN can be the subject to more than one challenge. This figure is the total number of challenges the council has received over the time period of this report.
- Note 5 In these cases the council considered it more appropriate to issue the motorist with a "warning" and cancelled the PCN
- Note 6 In these cases the council cancelled the PCN due to there being a legal issue with the serving of the PCN by the CEO or with the signing that indicates the parking restriction to the motorist
- Note 7 The council had to cancel these PCNs due to been unable to trace the owner of the vehicle
- Note 8 These cases were subject to late submission of evidence by the appellant which altered the council's stance on the case
- Note 9 Outcome agreed by both parties at TPT hearing and supported by the TPT Adjudicator
