

Public Spaces Protection Orders

Dog Fouling Signs

Dog fouling signs have to be erected before we can enforce the Public Spaces Protection Orders. These Orders include fouling, which covers any land in the open air within the East Riding of Yorkshire to which the public have access (with or without payment). Signs should only be placed on every 4th or 5th lamppost.

Only ERYC employees & contractors or Town & Parish Councillors & employees should erect signs.

Attachment of signs:

Signs may only be attached to:-

- Lamp posts owned by East Riding of Yorkshire Council, Parish or Town Council, if a new housing estate check the ownership first.
- Litter or dog bins owned by East Riding of Yorkshire Council, Parish or Town Council
- Posts, fences, walls or other owned by East Riding of Yorkshire Council, Parish or Town Council
- Privately owned posts, fences, walls or other **with written permission** of the land owner

Signs must **not** be attached to:-

- Telegraph Poles
- Road and Traffic Signs
- Lamp posts or other, where the sign obscures other information i.e. post number

Stencils

- Stencils may be applied to any hard surface footpath owned by East Riding of Yorkshire Council, Parish or Town Council
- Written permission is needed for any other land

It is recommended that permission is sought before applying to an area in front of a private driveway or pedestrian access. If in doubt over ownership don't stencil until clarification is established.
