



## **East Riding Local Plan Strategy Document and Allocations Document Modifications Statement of Representations Procedure**

The Council submitted the East Riding Local Plan for Independent Examination on 29 April 2014. The Secretary of State appointed Mr Simon Berkeley (BA MA MRTPI) to undertake the Examination. He held a series of hearing sessions to discuss the Plan during October and November 2014.

During the hearing sessions, the Council suggested a number of amendments to the Proposed Submission Strategy and Allocations Documents. The Inspector has requested that public consultation is undertaken on the Council's Modifications prior to finalising his report into the soundness of the Plan.

The proposed amendments are set out in the East Riding Local Plan Strategy Document and Allocations Document Schedules of Modifications (March 2015), which are accompanied by a Sustainability Appraisal Note, and are published for public consultation. Comments are also sought on various new documents that have been added to the Examination Library, as well as the impacts of the 2012-based household projections which were released by the Department of Communities and Local Government on 28 February 2015.

**The consultation will commence on Monday, 30 March 2015 and will close at 5pm on Monday, 11 May 2015.**

There is no need to resubmit previous representations. At this stage you are only able to make comments in relation to legal compliance, the duty to cooperate and the soundness of the Modifications. Please ensure your representation refers to the changes shown in the 'Schedule of Modifications' and includes the correct reference number (e.g. SM1).
