



**East Riding Local Plan Additional Schedule of Modifications  
(Allocations Document) - January 2016  
Statement of Representations Procedure**

The council submitted the East Riding Local Plan for Independent Examination on 29 April 2014. The Secretary of State appointed Mr Simon Berkeley (BA MA MRTPI) to undertake the Examination. He held a series of hearing sessions to discuss the Plan during October and November 2014, and additional hearing sessions were held in July 2015.

Following consultation on the Local Plan Modifications in March 2015, the council has proposed a further modification (reference: AM242) to the site SMB-B (Land North of A166, Stamford Bridge) in the Allocations Document. The proposed amendments are set out in the East Riding Local Plan Additional Schedule of Modifications (Allocations Document) January 2016. This is accompanied by a revised Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA) and Sustainability Appraisal (SA) Note.

**The consultation will commence on Monday, 18 January 2016 and will close at 5pm on Monday, 29 February 2016.**

Please note that comments are only sought on this new modification and cannot be made on other elements of the Plan. At this stage, you are only able to make comments in relation to legal compliance, the duty to cooperate and the soundness of the modification to Policy SMB-B. Please ensure your representation refers to the changes shown in the 'Additional Schedule of Modifications' (reference AM242).
