This Order is made by The East Riding of Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner or occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

Pollington Parish Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the Order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Pollington in the East Riding of Yorkshire and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in **Part 1 of the Schedule** to this Order shall be stopped up after seven (7) days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of seven (7) days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Pollington described in **Part 2 of the Schedule** and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of a section of Pollington Footpath No. 4 commencing at Grid Reference SE 6112 1920 (Point A on the Map) and leading north-easterly for some 4 metres to Grid Reference SE 6113 1920 (Point B on the Map) then turning south-easterly for some 145 metres to Grid Reference SE 6123 1911 (Point C on the Map).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A section of footpath commencing at Grid Reference SE 6112 1920 (Point A on the Map) and leading south-easterly along the south side of the field boundary for some 147 metres to join Balne Hall Road at Grid Reference SE 6123 1910 (Point D on the Map).

Width of new path or way

The new footpath will have a width of 1.8 metres with a centre line of 1.8 metres from the centre of the hedge.

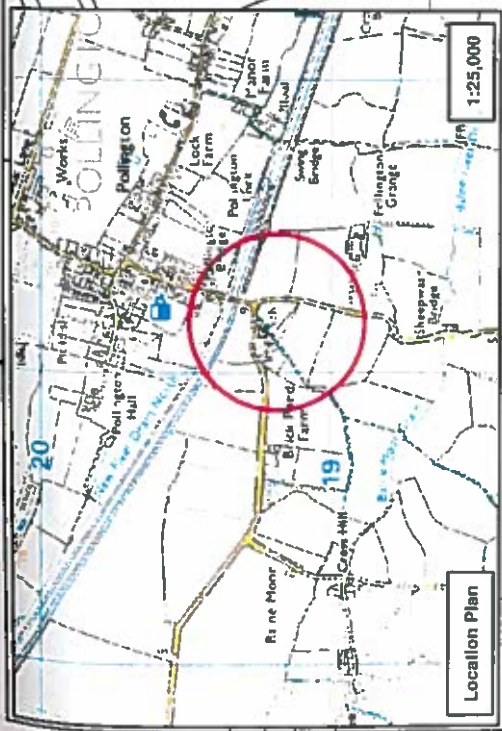

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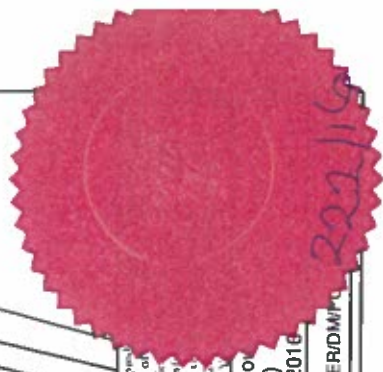
