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This Order is made by The East Riding of Yorkshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the Act') because it appears to that authority that the Humberside County Council Borough of East Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other evidence available to them) shows that two rights of way which are not shown in the map and statement subsist or are reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being rights of way such that the land over which the rights subsist are a public footpath and a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 26 March 2018.
2. The Humberside County Council Borough of East Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way shall be modified as described in Part I and II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (East Cottingwith Footpath No. 8 and Byway Open to All Traffic No. 9) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2018.

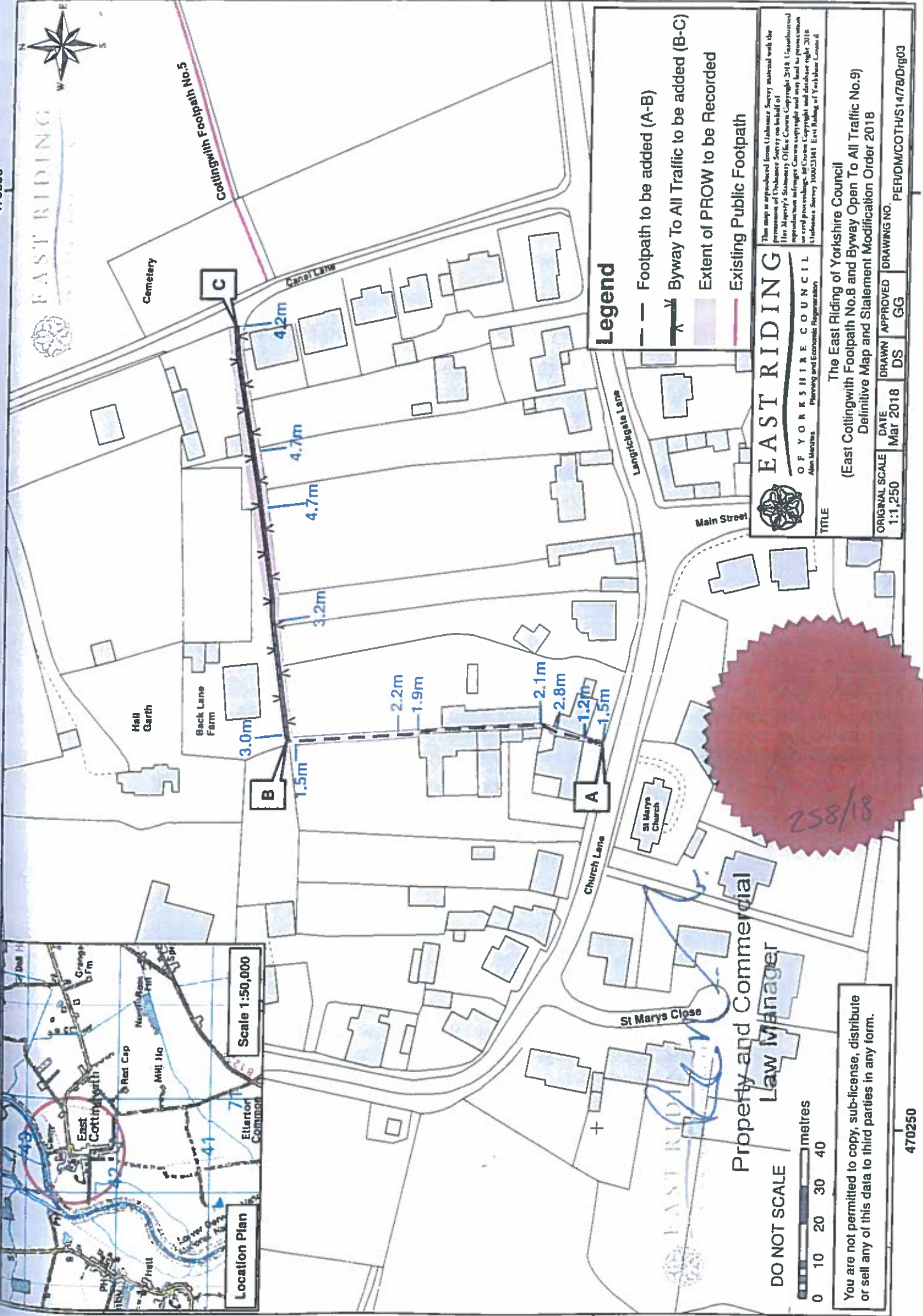

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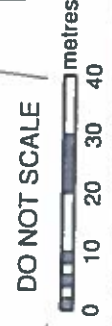

PART 1

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

Description of path or way to be added

- a) A public footpath in the parish of East Cottingwith commencing on Church Lane opposite St Marys Church at Grid Reference SE 7035 4249 (Point A on the Map) and leading north-north-easterly then northerly for some 88 metres to Grid Reference SE 7035 4258 (Point B on the Map).

The footpath varies in width between 1.2 metres and 2.8 metres as shown on the Map.

- b) A Byway Open to All Traffic in the parish of East Cottingwith commencing on the new footpath at Grid Reference SE 7035 4258 (Point B on the Map) and leading easterly for some 112 metres to join Canal Lane opposite the cemetery at Grid Reference SE 7046 4260 (Point C on the Map).

The Byway Open to All Traffic varies in width between 3.0 metres and 4.7 metres as shown on the Map.
