And We do also order direct and award set out and appoint that there shall at all times hereafter be a public highway as the same is staked or bounded out forty feet of assize in breadth and to be called the Mill Road leading from the said South West end of the said Hull Road Northward into thro and over the South Field to and from the North extremity of the Wind Corn Mill Dwelling and buildings of John Wright Miller.
