

COVID-19

Advice for Businesses w/e Wednesday 13 May 2020

From today (13 May 2020) people in England can spend more time outdoors and enjoy a wider range of activities for any length of time, subject to social distancing rules.

Individuals and their households can relax in the park, sunbathe, go for a picnic and go fishing.

They will also be able to spend time with one member of another household, one-on-one, as long as they adhere to strict social distancing guidelines at all times, staying 2 meters apart.

This will permit the following types of premises to open subject to adhering to the Government Guidelines.

- Tennis Clubs
- Golf Clubs
- Fishing lakes
- Bowls Clubs

The primary principles are set out below

- Exercise is **only permitted** to be undertaken **with people from your own household or 1 other person from another household as long as the minimum of 2 metre social distance can be maintained.**
- You can allow group exercise as long as all parties are from the same household.
- Exercise must take place in outdoors spaces only
- Careful cleanliness and consideration needs to be given to any communal areas people may need to access i.e. toilets
- You **cannot** open up any club houses/bars for use within the premises
- You can continue to offer takeaway food/drink facilities for consumption off site, as long as safe social distancing can be adhered to and your licence permits off sales if this would alcohol.
