**COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND IN BRIDLINGTON**

Notice is hereby given that the East Riding of Yorkshire Council (“the Council”) has made The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (35 Oatland Road, Bridlington) Compulsory Purchase Order 2021 under Section 17 of the Housing Act 1985. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for confirmation, and if confirmed, the order will authorise the Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of acquiring the house together with any land occupied with the house in order to return the house to beneficial use as housing.

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, National Planning Casework Unit, 5 St. Philip’s Place, Colmore Row, Birmingham B3 2PW before the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 2021, and should state the title of the order, the grounds of objection and the objector’s address and interests in the land.
