Re: Introduction of a Traffic Management Permit Scheme in the East Riding of Yorkshire

The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (“the Council”) has been preparing to operate a Street Works Permit Scheme (“the Scheme”) under Part 3 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and has now made an Order under that Act for the Scheme to commence operation.

As required by Regulation 4 of The Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, as amended in 2015, this letter is to inform you that the East Riding of Yorkshire Council Permit Scheme will start operation on 1 December 2021.

From 1 December 2021 (at 00:01) promoters of all works specified in the Scheme as requiring a permit must obtain such a permit from the Council before commencing works on the highway.

Promoters should refer to Statutory Guidance for Highway Authority Permit Schemes (October 2015) for details of the transitional arrangements that will apply, in particular for works that have started their notification processes under the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991. During the period of transition the Council will show leniency in the application of penalties from permit sanctions to allow for a period of learning and development. If however any promoter consistently commits an offence this leniency will immediately be removed for the remainder of the transition period.

The Council is committed to working with the promoters of works on their highways to achieve the objectives of the Scheme and its contribution to the better management of the Council’s highways.
