The enclosure Award states page 41 "another Private Road thirty feet in breadth branching out over the first mentioned Public Road at the south east corner of an allotment herein awarded to Jonathan Wilson and extending northwards to an allotment herein awarded to Robert Burton Esquire". The M62 cut this road in two, the southern half is shown on the OS Map as a ORPA and therefore keeps its vehicle rights. The northern end is on the list of streets and keeps its vehicle rights.
